Nurturing Hearts - 0 to 5 Program - Mondays (9am - 11am)

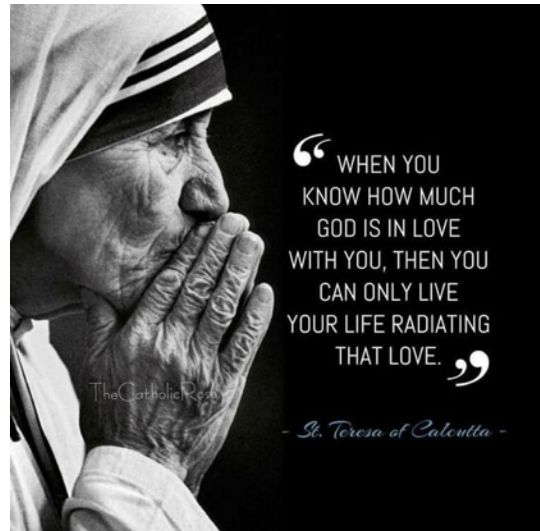
