### **Hats - Term 4**

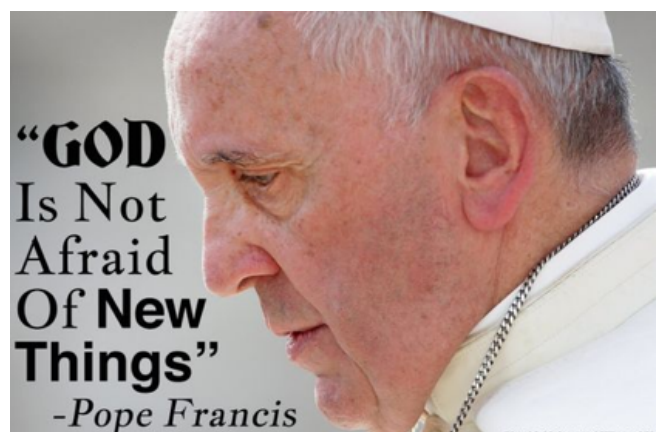
