




Wellbeing Strategy: Play Eat Learn

As communicated last week, this week we have commenced a trial of a 'flipped' model of the school day schedule - play, then eat, then learn.

There are a range of theoretical and practical implications for this change including:

- o The research: The body physiologically responds differently to the activities of playing and eating. Play arouses and heightens the body, whereas eating has a naturally calming effect. In our context, eating after play will allow students to have time to fuel their bodies and regulate their nervous systems prior to learning commencing for that session.
- The students: Many of our students rush to finish their food so as not to miss out on play, or finish at the same time as their friends. By eating together as a class group, after play, the anxiety caused by such a situation is diminished, allowing a more regulated state for learning to occur.



We thank families for their support in this space as we continue to strive to make Immaculate Heart the best we can for our students in their wellbeing, learning and growth as people.

Bush School: Kinder - Grade 4

According to recent research, "one in ten Aussie kids play outside once a week or less. We have become a nation of indoors, not outdoors" (From Climbing Trees: Getting Aussie Kids Back Outside). Our children play in very safe playgrounds or are involved in structured, organised sports and training events. More and more children spend time inside on devices such as computers, iPads and gaming consoles.









Our vision for Bush School is to give or students opportunities to connect with our natural environment, the local community and learn about our local indigenous cultural history. Bush School is a 'wilder' environment where risk and challenge is part of the experience. Children will be supported to build resilience, problem solving skills, teamwork, risk-taking and a sense of wonder.

There is a growing body of research, which strongly indicates that the benefits of active outdoor play are profound. Children with significant time outside had greater



development in concentration, play, creativity, physical development and social skills. From an environmental perspective, children who learn outdoors develop a deeper understanding of conservation and environmental issues.
