This week has been particularly significant for Mrs Kate Jackson, Mrs Therese Kelly, Mr Paul Egan and myself, with recognition of our 25 years of service in Catholic Education Tasmania.

St Mary of the Cross Mackillop Feast Day

Each year on the 8th of August we celebrate the Feast Day of Saint Mary of the Cross MacKillop, Australia's beloved first saint and patron saint of our school. On this day, we celebrate the important role she played in making education accessible for children in our country.





Mary MacKillop devoted her life to ensuring a holistic Catholic education for children from rural, poor families. St Mary MacKillop's impact on Australian education was remarkable.

Last week classes from Grade 1 to 6 had the opportunity to visit the Josephite History and Misson Centre to learn more about the work of Mary MacKillop, Fr Julian Tenison Woods and the Josephite Sisters. The Josephite's founded many schools across Tasmania in the 1800's and 1900's, including Immaculate Heart in 1961.



School Camps - Grades 3 to 6

Camps are seen as an integral part of learning at Immaculate Heart of Mary Catholic School. The camp experience enables students to explore, extend and enrich their learning and their social skill development, in a non-school setting. Our school camps are designed to engage students, build confidence and to build relationships with peers and teachers.

Positive Behaviour Support

This term at Immaculate Heart we have formally launched our Schoolwide Positive Behaviour Support Framework (PBS) as part of our review of our Wellbeing Strategy this year.



PBS <u>is an evidence-based</u>, tiered framework for supporting *students*' behavioural, academic, social, emotional, and mental health. PBS is proven to improve social emotional competence, academic success, and school climate when implemented in a schoolwide construct. It is a way to create positive, predictable, equitable and safe learning environments where everyone thrives.

All students have had initial teaching and learning around our new PBS framework and our staff have worked closely with Pastoral Care and Wellbeing leader, Susie Bond, to develop processes for teaching our first whole school focus of transitions.

Attached for our school community are two key documents in this journey. The first is our Positive Behaviour Support Matrix, which outlines our three key expectations, and the actions that will be taught and demonstrated throughout our school. The second is our Behaviour Flowchart, which outlines the processes for dealing with behaviour when things don't go to plan, and how we can best learn from things for the future.

Book Week Parade - Wednesday 23 August

Our much-anticipated Book Week parade will be held on the Astro at 9.00am on Wednesday 23 August. This is a great day where students and staff dress up as a book character. The theme for this year is "Read, Grow, Inspire". All parents are invited to attend.


Brixhibition Kids Competition 2023
