Anxiety - Parent Workshop



As part of our schoolwide approach to Wellbeing, at Immaculate Heart we aim to build an emotionally healthy community through science and practice. Over the past years, schools have seen an increase in "anxiety", the most common mental health condition in Australia.

To support our students, families and school to create an environment where students can thrive, Lisa Ford (Clinical Psychologist and founder of The Resilience Co.) will be facilitating student workshops, staff professional development and hosting a parent workshop on **Wednesday 29th November**.
