
Staff on Leave in 2024

Why I'm a Super Swim Hero

In February 2024, I'll be taking part in Super Swim to raise funds for the Starlight Children's Foundation.

Did you know that every minute of every day a sick child is admitted to hospital in Australia?

Please sponsor me to help me reach my fundraising goal and brighten the lives of sick kids in hospital.

My name is Charlie. I am 11 years old.



I was born with a rare disease called imperforate anus. IA is one of 7,000 conditions classified as rare diseases, or diseases that affect fewer than 200,000 people. IA is a congenital abnormality and affects 30,000 babies around the world each year. Without surgerical intervention at birth, I would have died within 24hr hrs.

Across my first year of life I spent a significant amount of time in hospital, particularly NICU.

I had three major surgeries before my first birthday.



I am a very healthy 11 year old now thanks to my medical team.

I cannot imagine the struggles children go through daily who have a continuing battle with serious illness.

I am swimming 15km in February to raise much needed funds to support children who are unwell.
