Capital Works - Building Project

Walk through video

Since being made aware of Maveric Builders as the successful tender for our upcoming works, much planning and preparation has been occurring in the background. Our project will definitely begin this term, with a final start date to be communicated at a meeting tomorrow (17 Oct). Once we are aware of the date, specific information will be circulated to families. This will include specifics as to the classroom structures of our Grade 2/3/4 students, any changes to locations of spaces or events, and any parking/traffic requirements. The walk-through video linked above takes you from the McCann Crescent entrance and into the Heart. From there, we journey into the library/hub space and into the first classroom. Down the 'amphitheatre' stairs and past small group learning spaces before walking through the two additional classrooms. Once finished inside, we see the undercover and accessible pathways and indoor-outdoor learning spaces of our current Prep/Grade 1 classrooms.
