


## Whole School Positive Behaviour Support Framework

In recent years Immaculate Heart has embedded our Schoolwide Positive Behaviour Support Framework (PBS) as part of our Wellbeing Strategy.

PBS is an evidence-based, tiered framework for supporting students' behavioural, academic, social, emotional, and mental health. PBS is proven to improve social emotional competence, academic success, and school climate when implemented in a schoolwide construct. It is a way to create positive, predictable, equitable and safe learning environments where everyone thrives.

Attached for our school community are two key documents in this journey. The first is our Positive Behaviour Support Matrix, which outlines our three key expectations, and the actions that will be taught and demonstrated throughout our school. The second is our Behaviour Flowchart, which outlines the processes for dealing with behaviour when things don't go to plan, and how we can best learn from things for the future.

Later in the week, the Building Project Team will meet to advise the progression of works.


#### Walk through video

These arrangements are in place to prioritise the safety of all students and adults, all day, every day:

- Restricted Access: Entry from McCann Crescent is now restricted.
- o Staff Car Park: Access to the staff car park will be limited during school hours.
- o Kiss and Drop Zone: This will be relocated to Edge Avenue at this time of the year.
- Pedestrian Access: All students and adults entering on foot through the staff car park must use the designated pathways.
- Assistance: If you require help accessing the school, please contact the school office.
- School Bus & School Van Parking: The driveway of the blue Astro Court is reserved for our school bus and van only.
- Supervision & Support: Our Leadership Team will be out and about to support the logistics and compliance with these changes.
- o Blue Astro Court 8:30 8:45am: To support safe access, kicking games will be restricted during this time as the Blue Court will be a major thoroughfare.

St Mary's Cathedral Parish are now accepting enrolments from students in Grades 3-6 for the 2025 Sacramental Program.


